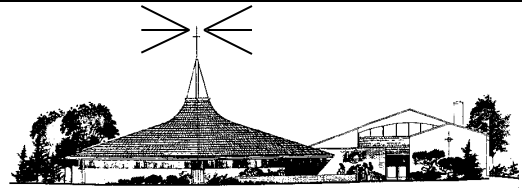

We have done a great job keeping our Blessing Box supplied with food for those in our community that are less fortunate. As we start into the warmer weather, Stock the Box suggestions for temperatures 40-85 are as follows:

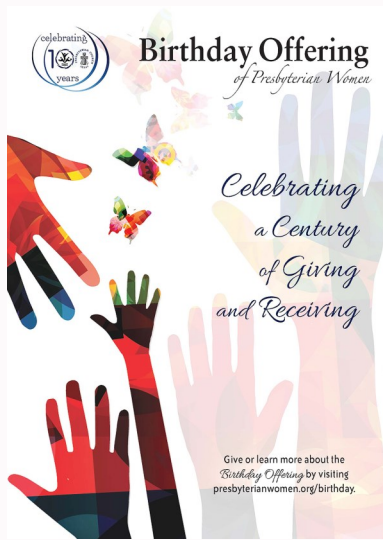
Canned soups and sauces. Canned meat (tuna, chicken, etc.) Peanut butter, nuts, and alternatives. Almond butter, Sunflower seed butter, Coconut butter, etc. Beans, canned, especially garbanzo, chili, & baked beans. Rice, white or brown. Pasta (preferably in boxes). Cereals/ instant oatmeal packets. Crackers/granola bars. Canned diced tomatoes, tomato sauce, & tomato paste. Canned fruits and vegetables. Condiments (ketchup, mustard, salad dressing, mayo). Jelly, pancake syrup. Baking and pancake mixes. Microwave meals/to-go meals, shelf-stable meal kits. Single serving size items. Protein drinks. Dried fruits. We thank each of you for what you are able to contribute.
